Several others spoke in similar strain. It was proposed by Capt Meikle, seconded by Mr.A.E.Rowell that an Association be formed consisting of Past and Present Members of the Armed Constabulary, Permanent Artillery, Torpedo Corps, and Royal N.Z.Artillery. Carried Unanimously.
